Usually when people refer to a movie or book as very "modern", they mean that it is up-to-date. Originally, though, the word "modern" had a different and more complex meaning. The adjective comes from Modernism, a philosophical and literary movement that took place in Europe and the United States roughly from 1860 through

1960. A discussion of Modernism might easily begin in the Renaissance period when we first encounter secular humanism and its notions of man (not God) being the measure of all things, a worldly civic consciousness, and a “utopian” vision of a more perfect society.

In retrospect we can recognize in Renaissance humanism the modernist expression of confidence that humankind can learn to understand and then master nature and natural forces, that we can grasp the nature of the universe, and that we can even shape our individual destinies and the future of the world.

The crux of the Modernist debate was the issue of whether Moderns were morally and artistically superior to the Ancients, i.e. the Greeks and Romans. This argument introduced an important dichotomy that still remains fundamental to the modernist question. In it we can recognize the division between the conservative forces, who tended to support the argument for the Ancients, and the relatively progressive forces, who sided with the Moderns.

Color psychology, a broadly accepted theory on the profound effect of color on human behavior and feeling, has the answers for all. Let’s consider some meanings and emotional associations that people tend to have with certain colors.

Red: The warmest color of the spectrum. The most passionate color can evoke the strongest emotions deeper inside, either positive or negative. It’s proven to stimulate a faster heartbeat and increase breathing rate. Red is almost synonymous with love and romance. Beside, the color red is considered an appetite stimulant; therefore, it is a popular decorating color used in the design schemes of restaurants.

Yellow: Cheerful and sunny yellow easily catches everyone’s attention. Now you understand why taxicabs are painted yellow. Surprisingly, even though it is usually associated with warmth and cheerfulness, scientific studies have shown that people tend to lose their tempers more often in yellow rooms and babies will cry more.

Since it's the most difficult color for the eyes to take in, it may have a disturbing effect if overused. However, since it's known as a great color to enhance memory and concentration, legal pads are usually yellow.

Black: Have you wondered why most villains or gangsters in the films often wear black? It's because black can make those wearing the color appear distant or evil. It's a color of authority and formality. Also, it is a popular color used in the fashion industry simply because it makes people look thinner than they actually are.

Nearly 90 percent of fashion experts unanimously agree that the color black in clothing is stylish and classic.

White: Contrary to black, white seems to have a more positive connotation. Brides have traditionally worn white wedding gowns to symbolize innocence and purity. When decorating or styling, white is the top choice because it's a neutral color that almost goes with everything.

Blue: The color of the sky and sea, opposed to emotionally tense colors like red and orange, is strongly associated with tranquility, chemicals, so it's commonly used to decorate bedrooms. Since blue usually gives the feeling of trust and loyalty, which interviews, according to many image consultants.
